Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to an order of the City of Sherwood, sealed bids will be received at the Sherwood City Hall until 2:00 PM, June 5, 2018, for furnishing all tools, materials and labor, and performing the necessary work for the construction of approximately 3449 linear feet of concrete sidewalk and appurtenances on Kelso Road from Arkansas Highway 107 to King Place on Burns Trail from King Place to North Valley Drive. At this time the bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The contractors shall make such inspection and studies of the site of the work as to familiarize themselves with all conditions to be encountered.

Each bid must be accompanied by an acceptable statement of bidder's qualifications. The requirements of the bidder's statement of qualifications will be furnished to prospective bidders with plans and specifications.

Each bid must be accompanied by an acceptable form of bid guaranty in the amount equal to at least five percent of the whole bid, and such bid bond or cashier's check shall be subject to the conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders.

Bids must be made upon the official bid sheets contained in the specifications, and such bid sheets SHALL NOT be removed from the remainder of the Specifications and Contract Documents. All bids shall be sealed and the envelopes addressed to Virginia Hillman, Mayor, City of Sherwood, 2199 E Kiehl Avenue, Sherwood, AR 72120. All bids

shall be plainly marked on the outside of the envelope specifying that it is a bid for Kelso Road and Burns Trail Sidewalks (ARDOT Job 061556), the time for opening of bids, and the name of the bidder.

Bidders are not required to have a contractor's license under the terms of Act 150, Arkansas Acts of 1965, as amended. However, the successful bidder must have a contractor's license in order to execute an agreement to complete this work in accordance with 23 CFR 635.110(c).

The Owner hereby notifies all bidders that this contract is subject to applicable labor laws, non-discrimination provisions, wage rate laws and other federal laws including the Fair Labor Standards Acts of 1938. The Work Hours Act of 1962 and Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 also apply.

The Owner hereby notifies all bidders that Buy America provisions apply to this project. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department's Standard Specifications Section 100 has requirements and restrictions for Buy America. Also, 23 CFR Sec. 635.410 has all of the federal requirements for Buy America.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informalities in the proposal deemed to be in the best interests of the Owner. The Owner further reserves the right to withhold the awarding of the contract for a period not to exceed 60 days after the receipt of bids.
